

STUDENT INTERCULTURAL EXCHANGE with ALAMOS, SONORA, MEXICO Fall Break 2023



HOW DOES THE STUDENT EXCHANGE WORK?

- Students will stay with host families with high school-aged host siblings and enjoy meeting and making wonderful new friends in Alamos
- Students will travel with SSCA Chaperone and Scottsdale Sister City members by luxury commercial bus costing about \$150 round trip
- Visits to culturally significant places in and around Alamos will be included
- Students will host their Alamos sibling in April of 2024

WHERE IS ALAMOS, MEXICO?

-Alamos is the first sister city of Scottsdale and the original capital of that part of Mexico when it was a Spanish Colony; it is located in the state of Sonora about 11 hours south of Scottsdale by motorcoach.

WHAT ARE THE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS?

- High school students in Scottsdale are eligible to apply to be an exchange student to Alamos during fall break 2023, leaving Friday night Oct. 6 and arriving back on Sat. the 14th around noon
- Students must have a passport prior to purchasing bus tickets, attend a Scottsdale area high school in 2023, and be between the ages of 15 – 18
- Students must complete a program application and meet with Scottsdale Sister Cities members for a student interview in early September.
